WEST MICHIGAN LEARNING CENTER FOR CHILDREN

The West Michigan Learning Center is one of more than 50 centers opened since 1994 by the Scottish Rite Masons in the 15 Northeastern States encompassing Wisconsin and Illinois to Delaware and Maine by the Scottish Rite Masons.

This program teaches children with DYSLEXIA to learn to read, write, and comprehend the English language. This program WORKS and within two to three years these students are equipped to keep up with their classmates in school. The student attends twice weekly sessions with a professional tutor who has been trained at the Center.

Any child may apply to these centers. There are no fees or charges to the parents or family and no restrictions on who may sign up. The only requirement is the child must be diagnosed with DYSLEXIA by a licensed psychologist. Approximately 15% of all humans are dyslexic to some degree and the public and parochial schools simply cannot afford the one-on-one tutoring that is required to make this change happen.

The Scottish Rite Masons began this program in 1994 with one Center in Boston followed by an expansion that was rapid and costly. The state of the economy hasn't helped either. It currently costs about \$5000 per child per year, and although there have been some improvements in shortening the process, the waiting list grows longer daily.
